Noah's Ark Children's Hospice

Noah's Ark supports families through difficult times. They work in Camden, Haringey, Barnet and Islington helping provide the care necessary for all the family at such a hard time.

Haven House

Haven house cares for children and young people between the ages of birth to 19 years who have life limiting conditions and are unlikely to reach adulthood. They help families from North and East London by providing a range of services that include day, short break and end of life care, together with therapeutic play in the community. Families can find the support they need, when they need it the most, at no cost to themselves.

Barnardos

Barnardos believes in children regardless of their circumstances, gender, race, disability or behaviour. Our purpose as a charity today is to transform the lives of the UK's most vulnerable children.

Rays of Sunshine

Rays of Sunshine Children's Charity exists to grant the wishes of children who are living with the serious or life threatening illnesses between the ages of 3-18 who live in the UK.

Comic Relief

In the UK comic relief helps give shelter to young people living on the streets and protection to those living with domestic abuse. In Africa they help save thousands of lives from malaria and provide whole communities with fresh water and life-saving vaccine's.

Myeloma UK

Myeloma UK works with patients, carers and family members to help them cope with everything a diagnosis of myeloma brings. St Mungos opens doors for homeless people and young people, mainly based in London and the south. They provide over 100 accommodations and support projects day and days out.

Burns unit at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital

The Burns Unit at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital is the only hospital service in London recognised by the South East of England Burns Network for the treatment of significant burns in children. All children are seen by a burns specialist, as well as relevant members of the paediatric team. Our four-bedded children's facility in the main Burns Unit is staffed by specialist burns nurses or nurses who are qualified in both burns and paediatrics. The burns service includes a walk-in burns clinic and two specialist burns dressings clinics.
