

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Body parts

Date: Monday 27 th April 2020	
Activity Title: Baby wash	
Learning Intention: Gradually able to engage in pretend play with toys.	Activity Overview: The children will wash the baby's and name the different parts of their body.
Links to EYFS: Personal social and emotional: Self-confidence and self-awareness-16-26 months	
Resources: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Water Tray/Bathtub • Dolls • Bubble bath • Towel • Cloths • Sponge 	Key vocabulary: Leg, arm, feet, eyes, arm, nose, wash, slow, fast, Cloths, mouth, ears, scrub, water, bubbles, smell, clean, dirty, brush, soft, hard.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
This is an activity we have carried out previously in Strawberry class. The children loved it!	
Introduction:	
*Test to see if your child knows what any parts of their body are called.	
* You can sing the song, head, shoulders, knees, and toes and Miss Polly had a dolly.

Main Activity:	
*Fill up a bucket, tray, or the bath with water.	
*Add the resources as listed above.	
*Use cloths, sponges, and brushes to scrub the dolls clean.	
* Talk about the different parts of the dolls body as your child is washing them.	
*Can you clean the dolls arm?	
*Can you use the sponge to wash the dolls feet?	
Review:	
Add jugs, cups, and pots for your child to practise pouring water.	
*Can you pour water over the dolls leg?	
*Can you fill up the jug with water?	
Additional ways to support your child: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Role model language throughout this activity. - Encourage your child to participate in this activity with their siblings. - Think about other songs which include body parts such as: Tommy thumb. 	Extension: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Give your child lots of resources to fill up and empty. - Introduce counting and numbers to this activity. <p>*Can you wash one of your dolls arms? *Can you wash two of the dolls feet.....1,2?</p>
