

COLOUR MIXING IDEAS

1. CLING FILM ART



Squeeze some paint on a piece of card.

Cover it with cling film.

Spread the paint, randomly criss-crossing with other colours.



2. SALAD SPINNER FUN

Cut out some circles from card or use a paper plate if available.

Place any of them in a center of the salad spinner.

Squeeze a generous amount of paint in the middle and cover it with the lid and give it a good whirl.

Remove the lid and let it dry.



3. BUBBLE PAINTING

Mix some water (half of your cup) with generous squirt of paint and washing up liquid together.

Let your child blow mountains of bubbles. They can even blow two cups of bubbles at the same time. Lay the sheet of paper on top of the cups, creating imprints.
