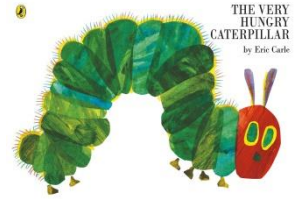


The Very Hungry Caterpillar

We have loved bringing it to life in class.

Drama is a very good way to help children with sequencing of stories; something that they will be looking at closely in their next year at nursery.

Warm Up

As always we start with a warm up and a stretch and a game.

Storytime

Then we read the story looking closely at the pictures talking about what we can see and what we think is happening in the picture.

I ask the children to come to the front of the class and using rubber spots to stand on, you don't need these, the children act out the story.

*I will add a video as an example.

It's a great way for them to recall the story, building there confidence and understanding of the story. I'm sure you will be surprised with what they can do!!

Read the statements and invite your child to role-play different parts of the story.

1. The leaf and the egg
2. Sunshine and out of the egg pops the caterpillar!!
3. Looks for food.. children to try and remember what he eats....
4. Has a tummy ache...eats a green leaf.
5. Big fat caterpillar.
6. Built a house around himself cocoon,
7. He was a beautiful butterfly.

They can now dance around floating like a butterfly... if you have colourful scarves or fabric they will be great to use.
