It's Monday today and we have amazing topic for you - People Who Help Us! This is a great topic that teaches us an incredible amount of useful information about the world, the environment and the amazing people (and their unique jobs) around us.

Try and focus on observing and reading stories, books and brochures that give you a broad knowledge of different people who help us, the tools they have, the buildings they use etc. Make sure you watch presentations and short videos of different professions such as doctor, teacher, plumber, mountain rescuer, all in order to bring the idea of that people who help us are everywhere and there is always someone who is ready to help other people in need.

A few more activities/ideas for parents:

- Snack Idea Let your child decorate pieces of paper with any people who help us stickers (foam stickers, cut out pictures from magazines...) to make place-mats for the lunch table.
- Movement Game Listen and Do Sit together with your child. Talk about different people who help us and give your child time to think and talk about them. Let your child pretend to be that animal and act out movements e.g. firefighter shutting down fire, doctor check-up...

Please encourage your children to look after their belongings like tidying up toys, hanging up their coats, putting their boots away etc. This will teach them to take care for, respect and maintain their own belongings and the school's equipment. Thank you!
