Dear Willow Class,

Good Morning! It's time to Explore, Learn and Have FUN! 😊

Today, our learning is based on the traditional tale of 'Chicken Licken'. To help you continue with home learning, we have prepared some learning ideas for you, based around the story of Chicken Licken, that you can try at home as a family.

Please have fun with all activities together & adapt them to fit your child's needs.

Some more ideas for parents:

-Guess who I am: use sounds/actions to act out some of the characters from the story. Can your child guess who you are? How could your child act out the same character? What other farm animals could Chicken Licken meet? How many animals can your child name? Challenge your child to act out the characters, e.g. a mouse - scurry on all fours as fast as possible? Can you guess who they are? What sounds could your child make, e.g. 'squeak' for a mouse or 'moo' for a cow to help you guess?

-Counting eggs: how far can your child count on his/her own? To 5, 10, 15 or 20? Show your child a box of 12 eggs. Take some of the eggs out of the box. Can your child count how many are in the box? How many out of the box? What number is bigger/smaller or more/ fewer? Practise only saying one number for each egg counted. Try different numbers.

-Sing Old Macdonald - ask your child where does the story take place (a farm)? Talk about what it might be like on a farm. Sing the song old MacDonald. Talk about 'baby' farm animals, e.g. a baby pig is a 'piglet'. We wish you a great day, full of fun, love, health and happiness 😊
