

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Monday 6th April 2020	
Activity Title: Painting/Drawing	
Learning Intention: To create a piece of artwork based on Charlie Cook's favourite book.	Activity Overview: To use paints/pencils to create a piece of art linked to Charlie Cook's favourite book.
Links to EYFS: To create simple representations of events, people and objects.	
Resources: Paint, Brushes, Paper, Pencils, Crayons.	Key vocabulary: Book, Armchair, Paint, Paintbrush, Paper, Design.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
<p>Introduction:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Familiarise your child with the image below of Charlie Cook in his armchair and explain that today s/he is going to draw or paint the image. <p>Main Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Looking at the picture, talk with your child about the different shapes that can be seen and used to create your painting/drawing. Refer to the image and ask your child to name which colours they can see and use to create their painting/drawing. (If you are painting) Encourage your child to mix and create colours they would like to use to represent their painting. (If you are drawing) Collect a variety of colours you previously discussed and ask your child to outline where they would like to use each colour. <p>*Get creative – draw or paint the image!</p> <p>Key Questions</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> What part of the picture are you going to paint first? Which colour do you need? What shapes is the chair made up of? (Painting) How can you make this colour? 	
Additional ways to support your child: Demonstrate the activity by painting/drawing a picture of Charlie in his chair reading.	Extension: Draw or paint another picture from the story Charlie Cook's favourite book.
