Main Activity:


 Have a discussion with your child about the story. Use the questions below.


Questions to ask:

- 1. Who is your favourite character and why?
- 2. Where is your story set? (forest, space, ocean)
- 3. What happens in the beginning/middle/end?
- 4. Who is the main character?
- 5. How does the cover of the book relate to the story?
- 6. What is your favourite part of the book and why?
- 7. Can you think of an alternative ending?
- 8. What could happen next?

Challenge:

- Ask your child what books they like to read and whether they could pick their favourite.
- Get your child to describe their favourite book and give a small overview of the story.
- Ask your child what they enjoy about the book and why it's their favourite.
