

# Individual Activity Lesson Plan

<b>Date:</b> Monday 6 <sup>th</sup> April 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> What's your favourite book?	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> Discuss their favourite book using language to effectively answer questions.	<b>Activity Overview:</b> Use language effectively to answer questions and discuss your favourite book.
<b>Links to EYFS: Literacy: Reading:</b> Describes main story setting, events and principal character. Beginning to be aware of the way stories are structured. Suggest how the story might end.  <b>Communication &amp; Language: Speaking:</b> Uses vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by their experiences of books. Uses talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feeling and events.

<b>ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)</b>	
<b>Introduction:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Listen to "Charlie Cook's favourite book" using the link above.</li> <li>• Discuss the different stories within the book.</li> </ul>	
<b>Main Activity:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have a discussion with your child about the story. Use the questions below.</li> </ul>	
<b>Questions to ask:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Who is your favourite character and why?</li> <li>2. Where is your story set? (forest, space, ocean)</li> <li>3. What happens in the beginning/middle/end?</li> <li>4. Who is the main character?</li> <li>5. How does the cover of the book relate to the story?</li> <li>6. What is your favourite part of the book and why?</li> <li>7. Can you think of an alternative ending?</li> <li>8. What could happen next?</li> </ol>	
<b>Challenge:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask your child what books they like to read and whether they could pick their favourite.</li> <li>• Get your child to describe their favourite book and give a small overview of the story.</li> <li>• Ask your child what they enjoy about the book and why it's their favourite.</li> </ul>	
<b>Additional ways to support your child:</b> Choose your favourite story and work through the questions above, giving your child an idea of the answers they could provide.	<b>Extension:</b> Encourage your child to draw a picture of what might happen after the story finishes.
