ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)		
Introduction:		
• First, cut off the top of the box.		
 Next, make two holes for the hands. 		
 In the holes, place/stick gloves. 		
• Then, fill the box with material such as salt, sand, stones, things you have at home.		
• Finally, cover the box with plastic wrap and you are ready for the activity.		
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Main Activity: Allow your child to discover (touch and feel) different types of materials placed in the box.

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Focus on thinking and talking skills. Allow your child time to think and talk, focus on modelling descriptive vocabulary.

Additional ways to support your child:	Extension:
 Ask your child questions so they can describe what they feel. 	 Gather objects from the garden and discuss and categorise them (consider different concepts big/little, smooth/rough round/not round etc.).
