Date: Thursday 09 April 2020 Activity Title: Catching Stars – There's No Place like Space	
 Resources: Stars (cut out paper stars, if don't have plastic stars available) Jar/container/bowl Tray Black beans Tongs, scoops, ladle Story link: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Sl4QuS2S</u> 	
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
 Introduction: Watch and listen to the story in focus – Click on to the link above. Give your child an opportunity to talk about his/her thoughts and prompt where s/he can see stars. Where can you find the stars? How many can you see? What do you notice? Main Activity: Explain that you are going to create the sky/galaxy for him/her to catch the stars. Invite your child to help you set up the activity using the resources available. Model how to catch a star whilst verbalising your thinking. 'This is very exciting, I'm going to catch the red star using my tongs, oh no it's tricky – it's fallen I'm going to try again. I'm going to put it in the jar and thenetc. Make it fun by using intonation and facial expressions and let them play and explore to find their own ways of catching the stars. I wonder which star you're going to catch next? Yellow, blue, white – can you say which star you're going to catch next? Can you describe what you are doing? Challenge: Hang the stars from a line and see if they can catch them. Hang the stars from the line so they can reach them standing on their toes. 	
 Additional ways to support your child: Test catching the stars using all the different tools and have fun! Cheat at times by picking the star up with your hands to see your child's response. 	 Extension: Count how many stars you have been able to catch.
