

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Thursday 30th April 2020

Activity Title: Junk Modelling – People Who Help Us

Learning Intention:

To use recyclables to make a model e.g. binoculars, helmet, telephone.

Links to EYFS: Expressive Art and Design: Uses various construction materials.

Resources:

- Card board, paint, scissors
- Kitchen roll, fabrics
- Newspaper, string/wool
(Any other materials you can recycle.)

Activity Overview:

Use any reusable items to make a model of your choice.

Key vocabulary:

Model, make, measure, materials, recycled, I wonder..., Let's try this...,

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Show your child a selection of different junk modelling resources.
- Give them the opportunity to hold, feel and describe the different textures.

Main Activity:

*Challenge your child to make a sculpture/ model using the recyclable materials you have gathered.

*Use the photos below for inspiration. Can you make an object linked to our topic – People who Help Us?

*Listen to your child's ideas and encourage them to make something from their imagination. ["Oh I wonder how you will do that."](#)

*Support your child with the different processes required and remember this is where the development is (try not to focus solely on the outcome).

*Can you show me how we hold the scissor/pencil

* Can you describe what you are making?

*Let's work together to cut the Sellotape.
