ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Show your child a selection of different junk modelling resources.
- Give them the opportunity to hold, feel and describe the different textures.
- Is this material plastic or paper?
- What was inside this box?

Main Activity:

- *Challenge your child to make a sculpture/ model using the recyclable materials you have gathered.
- *Use the photos below for inspiration. Can you make an object linked to our topic People who Help Us?
- *Listen to your child's ideas and encourage them to make something from their imagination. "Oh I wonder how you will do that."
- *Support your child with the different processes required and remember this is where the development is (try not to focus solely on the outcome).
- *I wonder what you will make?
- * I wonder how you will put that together?
- *Can you show me how we hold the scissor/pencil
- * Can you describe what you are making?
- *Let's work together to cut the Sellotape.
