

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Monday 27th April 2020

Activity Title: Put out that Fire! - People Who Help Us

Learning Intention:

To know the importance of a firemen/women and to role-play putting out a fire.

Links to EYFS:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development: Enjoys the responsibility of carrying out small tasks.

Resources:

- Spray bottle with water (you could use an old cleaning spray bottle – ensuring it has been thoroughly rinsed out)
- Chalk

Activity Overview:

Pretend to put out the fire using a spray bottle or hose pipe.

Key vocabulary:

Fire, put out, fire-fighter, hot, flames, spray.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

Use chalks to draw a flame on the floor (invite your child to do this) and provide your child with water inside a spray bottle.

- Can you tell me what this is on the floor?
- I wonder who puts out fires?

Main Activity:

Explain to your child that they are going to practise putting out a fire, like a little fire-fighter.

Then let your child have fun, by spraying the water spray bottle at the fire. 'I wonder if you be able to put all of the fire out'

- I wonder how you will put the fire put?
- I wonder if we need hot water or cold water?
- Do we go close to open fire? Why not?
- How to we use fire



Additional ways to support your child:

- Talk about health and safety, how you stay safe in your home.

Extension:

- Use junk modelling to create a fire extinguisher, oxygen tank, hose and other firefighters associated tools.
