

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Tuesday 28th April 2020

Activity Title: Making a Paper Whale

Learning Intention: To understand that media can be manipulated to create props.

Links to EYFS: To create simple representations of events, people and objects.

Resources:

- A4 piece of paper
- Small white square of paper
- Blue/grey pencil/crayon
- Black pencil/crayon
- Scissors

Activity Overview: Use your fine motor skills to colour and fold paper to create a whale.

Key vocabulary: Paper, fold, create, make, change, colour, cut, safety, safely, scissors, carefully.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Listen to today's story 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson.
- Explain to your child that today they are going to be creating their own whale using paper.
