ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)

Introduction:

- Listen to the story "What the Ladybird Heard"
- Discuss with your child why somebody might use a map.

Main Activity:

- Get your child to draw a map of the farm; encourage them to draw the farm animals and their houses.
- Help your child to label each key image on the map asking them to describe what they are e.g. Cow shed ("It's where the cows on the farm live).
- Talk with your child about how the map will work helping them add a starting point, end point and directional arrows.



Questions:

- How many farm animals live on your farm?
- What house does live in?
