


# Individual Activity Lesson Plan

<b>Date:</b> Monday 6th April 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> Painting/Drawing	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> To create a piece of artwork based on Charlie Cook's favourite book.	<b>Activity Overview:</b> To use paints/pencils to create a piece of art linked to Charlie Cook's favourite book.
<b>Links to EYFS:</b> To create simple representations of events, people and objects.	
<b>Resources:</b> Paint, Brushes, Paper, Pencils, Crayons.	<b>Key vocabulary:</b> Book, Armchair, Paint, Paintbrush, Paper, Design.
<b>ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)</b>	
<p><b>Introduction:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Familiarise your child with the image below of Charlie Cook in his armchair and explain that today s/he is going to draw or paint the image.</li> </ul> <p><b>Main Activity:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Looking at the picture, talk with your child about the different shapes that can be seen and used to create your painting/drawing.</li> <li>Refer to the image and ask your child to name which colours they can see and use to create their painting/drawing.</li> <li>(If you are painting) Encourage your child to mix and create colours they would like to use to represent their painting.</li> <li>(If you are drawing) Collect a variety of colours you previously discussed and ask your child to outline where they would like to use each colour.</li> </ul> <p>*Get creative – draw or paint the image!</p>	
	
<p><b>Key Questions</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What part of the picture are you going to paint first?</li> <li>Which colour do you need?</li> <li>What shapes is the chair made up of?</li> <li>(Painting) How can you make this colour?</li> </ol>	
<b>Additional ways to support your child:</b> Demonstrate the activity by painting/drawing a picture of Charlie in his chair reading.	<b>Extension:</b> Draw or paint another picture from the story Charlie Cook's favourite book.
