

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Monday 6 th April 2020	
Activity Title: What's your favourite book?	
Learning Intention: Discuss their favourite book using language to effectively answer questions.	Activity Overview: Use language effectively to answer questions and discuss your favourite book.
<p>Links to EYFS: Literacy: Reading: Describes main story setting, events and principal character. Beginning to be aware of the way stories are structured. Suggest how the story might end.</p> <p>Communication & Language: Speaking: Uses vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by their experiences of books. Uses talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feeling and events.</p>

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
<p>Introduction:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Listen to "Charlie Cook's favourite book" using the link above. ● Discuss the different stories within the book. <p>Main Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Have a discussion with your child about the story. Use the questions below. <p>Questions to ask:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Who is your favourite character and why? 2. Where is your story set? (forest, space, ocean) 3. What happens in the beginning/middle/end? 4. Who is the main character? 5. How does the cover of the book relate to the story? 6. What is your favourite part of the book and why? 7. Can you think of an alternative ending? 8. What could happen next? <p>Challenge:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Ask your child what books they like to read and whether they could pick their favourite. ● Get your child to describe their favourite book and give a small overview of the story. ● Ask your child what they enjoy about the book and why it's their favourite. 	
<p>Additional ways to support your child: Choose your favourite story and work through the questions above, giving your child an idea of the answers they could provide.</p>	<p>Extension: Encourage your child to draw a picture of what might happen after the story finishes.</p>
