
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)

Introduction:

- Listen to the story of Charlie Cook's favourite book being read using the link provided.
- Now explain to your child that today's activity is based on counting characters and writing numbers.

Main Activity:

- After familiarising your child with the story, explain you will replay the video and they will be counting the characters reading a book.
- Whilst identifying the characters reading a book (pause the video) and encourage your child to write the number they have counted forming a number line.
- Use the number formation sheet to encourage your child to form the numbers correctly.



 Once your child has counted the characters and written the numbers you can use the questions below to play a number game.

Number Questions:

What number comes after ...?

What number comes before ... ?

Which number comes in between ... and ... ?

Can you tell me the number that comes next in the number line?

Can you write it?

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Additional way	vs to supi	port vour	child:
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Using a marker write large numbers your child can trace over.

Extension:

Watch the story again and pause it on a random page. Now, ask your child to count the number of a particular item on the screen. E.g. how many birds are on this page?
