

Individual Activity Lesson Plan (Spring/Growing)

Date: Friday 3rd April 2020

Activity Title: Flower Printing

Learning Intention: To show control in holding and using mark making tools.

Activity Overview:
Your child will use various sizes of pre cut flowers, made from kitchen roll and toilet roll tubes, to print a flower garden.

Links to EYFS:
Physical Development-Moving and Handling-22-36 months

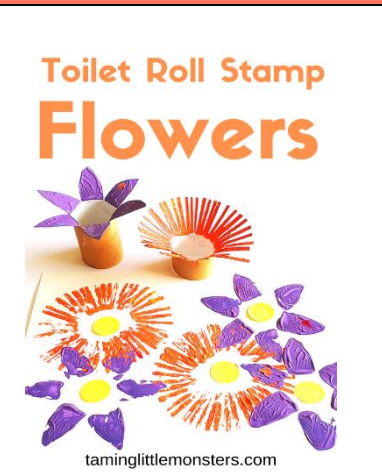
Resources:

- Paint
- Kitchen/toilet roll
- Scissors
- Paper
- Tray/bowls/plates (for the paint).

Key vocabulary:
Spring, flower, roll, stamp, colour names, garden, colourful, petal, cut, scissors.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:



- ❖ First find as many kitchen/toilet rolls as you can.
- ❖ Cut strips to make a petal shape, as you can see in the picture below.
- ❖ Put coloured paint/s in trays/bowls/plates.
- ❖ Then, you are ready to paint with your child!
- ❖ Ask our child:

- *Which colour are you going to use?
- *Is this a big flower or small flower?

Main Activity:

- ❖ Encourage your child to dip the roll into the coloured paint and make marks on the paper provided.

- *What does it look like?
- *How many flowers did you put in your garden?
- * What colours did you use?



Activity review:

- ❖ Invite your child to review their artwork and comment on what they like. Model this for them e.g. 'I like the way you have used lots of different colours'.
- ❖ You can read the story "A Seed in Need" by Sam Godwin in order to support your child's learning.
