Activity Title: Night Writing – Orion and The Dark	
Learning Intention: To sometimes give meaning to mathematication they draw and write. Links to EYFS: Literacy: Writing: 30-50 months.	Activity Overview: To create a dark writing station, for the night write. You could use your den from the previous activity.
Resources: Large clear plastic box (Tupperware would be ideal) Paper/Sellotape Torch/Lamp (you could use the torch on a mobile pho Highlighters – assorted (or any writing tools)	Key vocabulary:Write, mark, lamp, torch exciting, clever, fun,letter, shape, similarities, differences,describe, pattern, repeat, copy, create,continue.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions	5)
 Introduction: Introduce the story in focus, listen and watch by clicking on the link below. Orion and the Dark story link: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0086aJXQN4w Explain that today your child is going to experience mark making in the dark. Gather all the resources from around the house to make a night writing station (use the den you created in the previous activity). Give your child a moment to explore. What resources shall we use? 	
 Main Activity: *Explain that we are going to create a night writing station using all the resources we have selected together. 1) Place a torch under an upside down clear plastic box. 2) Place paper on top of the plastic box (You may want to Sellotape the paper on so it does not move.) 3)Use the highlighters to make marks on the paper – this is your night writing. I wonder what you will use next. Paper, Sellotape– can you say what we need next? Can you describe the marks you've made? Can you describe the marks I've made? 	
Challenge:	
Can you trace your name? Can you write your name?	
Additional ways to support your child: -Support your child with holding the writing tools. Model how to hold the highlighter/pen.	 Extension: Challenge your child to predict what will happen when they test other mark marking resources like crayons or felt tips.
