Activity Title: Alien handprints	
Learning Intention: Expressive arts and design	Activity Overview: Using handprints to create an

## **ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)**

#### Introduction:

- Show your child space books/pictures (Aliens love underpants by Claire Freedman)
- Explain that you and your child are going to paint your hands to create an Alien
- You can model this first
- Let your child paint your hands and their own
- Let them be imaginative when decorating their spaceship

## **Main Activity:**

- Paint your hands (green if you have it) and make a handprint on your paper (white paper works better), leave this to dry
- Make your spaceship use a small plate to make the base of the ship, draw around the bottom of the plate to create a semi-circle
- Make a rectangle shape to go on top of your semi-circle mummy or daddy can help you cut out these shapes
- Glue your two pieces together and decorate your spaceship, leave this to dry
- Draw little alien faces on top of each finger and thumb, do this on your painted hands
- Cut around your painted handprints to make a bubble shape around your hands (this is the top of your spaceship)
- Glue this top part to the rest of your spaceship
- Wow, look at the fabulous "Alien in a flying saucer" you have made, send a photo we would love to see what you have created

### **Activity review:**

- "what shapes can you see" "how many fingers have you got" count together
