Good Morning Rosewood,

Today you will be reading the story *Rumble in the Jungle* by Giles Andreae. I wonder how many jungle animals you will find in the story. I wonder what your favourite jungle animal is.

In today's story you will meet a great range of animals, who all live in this habitat. This wonderful story includes lots of rhyme. I wonder if you can remember what rhyming words are. That's right they're words with the same or similar sound ending. For example bug and rug are rhyming words (we can hear the word endings sound the same), whereas bug and hat are not (the word endings sound different). Today you will be looking for rhyming pairs of words in our story and then playing an odd one out rhyming game.

I hope you've all been practising your maths skills with learning from our weekly activity sheet. We have a special maths game for you to play today - you will need to help a monkey climb to the top of a tree! After exploring the sounds of the jungle, you will also be getting creative to make your own rain stick. Doesn't that sound exciting?!
