

# Individual Activity Lesson Plan



<b>Date:</b> Tuesday 5 <sup>th</sup> May 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> Make a house for your mouse family to live in.	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> To use your imagination to build a house for a mouse. (EAD)	<b>Activity Overview:</b> Letting your child choose what materials to use, encourage them to use their imagination.
<b>Links to EYFS:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beginning to make believe by pretending. (EAD-BI-22-36months)</li> </ul>	
<b>Equipment:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shoe box/ any small box</li> <li>Fabric</li> <li>cotton wool</li> <li>Any natural materials e.g. straw, hay, grass, leaves, twigs.</li> </ul>	<b>Key vocabulary:</b> What are you going to use? How are you going to make it? I like the way you are doing that
<b>ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)</b>	
<b>Introduction:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read 'The Smartest Giant in town' book with your child/children (you can look online if you don't have it) <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cfiPrA8E3qE">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cfiPrA8E3qE</a></li> <li>In the story the giant gives the mice his shoe for them to live in. Think about what materials and resources you can use to make a house for the mice.</li> <li>Look at different styles of houses including animals' homes.</li> </ul>	
<b>Main Activity:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Have all the materials ready before you start. Collect natural materials from the garden/park.</li> <li>With guidance, let your child build a house for the mouse family while asking open ended question such as, "how did you do that?", "what are you using?" " what do mice need?" etc</li> <li></li> </ul>	
<b>Activity review:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What did your child learn from this?
