Date: Monday 4 th May 2020 Activity Title: I Spy With My Little Eye – Activity Sheet	
Links to EYFS: Personal, Social and Emotional Development	template.
 * 'I Spy' Activity Sheet – Printed if possible; however it can be used on a device. * Tablet/Computer if using the screen. 	Key vocabulary: Guess, look, find, see, eye, describe, where.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Print or view the 'I Spy Activity Sheet' and encourage your child to talk and describe what they can see
- What can you see?
- What is this called? Point to item.
- Describe specific features which make this particular item stand out. Encourage your child to really observe what they can see.

Main Activity:

• Explain to your child that you are going to play a finding game together. You will say a specific item on the page and then will encourage them to look and find it.

- Can you find me a pair of scissors with the red handle?
- Where is the brown table?
- Do you know where the big orange pencil is?
- Try to be as specific as possible and give your child lots of clues to help them find what they are looking for.
- Praise your child for taking part in the activity.

Challenge

Encourage your child to group the items together on the sheet and to count how many they have e.g.

- Can you find all the pairs of scissors? How many did you find?
- Can you count everything that is yellow?
- Praise your child for persisting with each challenge.
