

Individual Activity Lesson Plan



Date: Thursday 7 th May 2020	
Activity Title: Making a den	
Learning Intention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> help your child channel their imagination 	Activity Overview: Let your child use their imagination to build a den.
Links to EYFS: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> help your child channel their imagination (EAD) 	
Resources: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> fabric boxes string pegs torches cushions 	Key vocabulary: What will you need? How will you do it Who shall we make it for? I like the way you are doing that, well done. Den, build, balance, cushions, torch, light, dark, peg, string, pull, cut, boxes.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)	
Introduction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look at the book "The smartest giant in town" and talk about the fox in his tent. Get your child to think about what resources they will need to make a Den. Walk around the house and collect the resources you need. 	
Main Activity: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide safe/fun equipment. Talk about how and where people/animal's live. Encourage your child to use their imagination. Ask questions such as "how? Why? What do we need?" Build your Den using the equipment you previously collected from around the house. Fill it with cushions/torches. Read "The smartest giant in town" inside the Den, whilst having a healthy snack 	
Activity review: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What resources did you need to make a Den? If you were to make a Den again would you use any different resources? IS it light or dark inside the Den? 	
Additional ways to support your child: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Help when necessary, encourage your child to use their imagination. 	Extension: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> On a nice sunny day build a larger Den outside and talk about camping.
