

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Tuesday 19th May 2020

Activity Title: Bubble Painting - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=z4i3Pp_ciwA

Learning Intention:

To understand that different media can be combined to create a new effect.

Activity Overview:

To follow instructions to engage with bubble painting.

Links to EYFS: Expressive Arts and Design

Resources:

- Washing up liquid
- Paint
- Straw
- Paper
- Water

Key vocabulary:

Bubble, pop, paint, round, colour, blow, straw.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Explain to your child that he/she is going to do bubble painting.
- Give him/her a selection of coloured paints to choose from.
- Follow the link above to find out how to bubble paint.

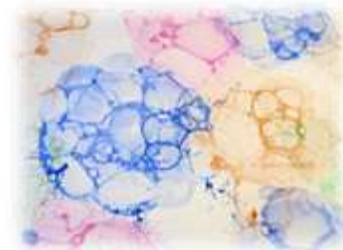


Main Activity:

- Mix together the paint with some washing up liquid, in the tray. Add some water until it is runny enough to blow bubbles. Use the drinking straw to blow into the paint to make bubbles.
- Model to your child how to blow to make the bubbles using a straw. (Don't drink it!)
- Gently place the paper on top of the bubbles. When the bubbles pop remove the paper and leave to dry.

'I'm going to blow softly and watch the bubbles.'

- I wonder how big the bubble will be.
- I wonder if you can blow gently.
- What do you need to do now?
