Individual Activity Lesson Plan - Rising 3's



Date: Tuesday 5 th May 2020	
Activity Title: The colours/ Los colores	
Learning Intention: To learn new words rapidly and use them confidently. Links to EYFS: Communication and language: Speaking	Activity Overview: Learn colours in Spanish, by listening to a special song and playing colour games.
Resources: Song link: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xDa22ECW7GY	Key vocabulary: rojo /red; blue/ azul; yellow/amarillo; verde/ green.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Follow the link above to listen and learn a song about colours in Spanish!
- Encourage your child to repeat different words (colours/ objects) mentioned in the song.

Main Activity:

1) Matching Colours

Call out a colour in Spanish and challenge your child to run and point to an object in the room which is this colour.

2) Colour Hunt

Go on a colour hunt around your house. You could make a set of colour monsters (as shown in the photograph). Ensure you continue to repeat the colour names in Spanish and encourage your child to do so to.



3) Corners

You will need several family members to play this game. Place an object of each colour in each corner of a room. Play music and dance around: when the music stops, all players should run to a corner of the room. The person controlling the music should then call out one of the colours (in Spanish) and anyone standing in the corner where this coloured object is, is out.

Challenge:

Swap roles in the matching colours game. Can your child call out one of the colour names in Spanish, for you to then run and find an object of this colour?
