ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- -Explain that today you are going to build a den together!
- -Invite your child to think about the resources needed and work together to gather what's required.

Main Activity:

Use the equipment and tools to create the den together.

- What is the den made of?
- Which materials shall/did we use?
- How can we make sure the den will stay together?
- -Add some toys and encourage your child to develop his/her own role play.
- -Use lots of language, gestures and facial expressions to enhance the role-play and your child's understanding and involvement.
- -Encourage your child to be creative and to develop their imaginative skills and play ideas.
 - Can you describe the den you've made?
 - What shall we play in the den?
 - What would you like me to do?
