

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Thursday 7 th May 2020	
Activity Title: Building A Den	
Learning Intention -To keep play going by responding to what others are saying or doing. -To enjoy the responsibility of carrying out small tasks.	Activity Overview: Build a den using different resources. One made, use the den for role-playing.
Links to EYFS: Personal, Social and Emotional Development	
Resources : Boxes Cushions Table Blankets/material Toys	Key vocabulary: Create, build, make, play, design, big, small, wobbly, secure, home.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
Introduction: -Explain that today you are going to build a den together! -Invite your child to think about the resources needed and work together to gather what's required.	
Main Activity: Use the equipment and tools to create the den together. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is the den made of? Which materials shall/did we use? How can we make sure the den will stay together? -Add some toys and encourage your child to develop his/her own role play. -Use lots of language, gestures and facial expressions to enhance the role-play and your child's understanding and involvement. -Encourage your child to be creative and to develop their imaginative skills and play ideas. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you describe the den you've made? What shall we play in the den? What would you like me to do? 	
Challenge Encourage your child to create their own stories for you to listen to and act out together inside the den.	
Additional ways to support your child: Role model what you are asking your child to do. Play alongside them and encourage them to share their play ideas.	Extension: If possible keep the den up (or move it to somewhere more appropriate). Use the den as a quiet space for the next few days. It could be a place for reading, doing puzzles/jigsaws, drawing or even napping in.
