### **ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)**


#### Introduction:

- Watch the story: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gKWktweAZb0">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gKWktweAZb0</a>
- Gather the resources listed above and explain to your child that they are going to create their own wolf.
- Print out the template, or alternatively trace around the template pieces and cut them out.

#### **Main Activity:**

- If desired, paint the paper bag grey and let it dry completely.
- Glue or tape the nose, tongue and mouth onto the front of the paper roll.
- Glue the eyes and ears onto the head.
- Glue the arms onto the paper roll
- Glue/tape the tail onto the back.
- Once dry this is your paper roll wolf!

<sup>\*</sup>Gather small world characters (if available - otherwise use your imagination) and have lots of fun retelling the story with props.






### Additional ways to support your child:
