ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Recap/watch today's focus story The Ant and the Grasshopper (see link above)
- Would you rather be an ant or a grasshopper? Why?

Main Activity:

- Print out the stick puppet templates (or draw your own).
- Support your child with cutting the templates out.
- Attach glue to lollypops/craft sticks and attach the puppets (position the puppets near the top of the sticks).
- Once the glue has dried, your stick puppets are ready Enjoy ©
- Role-play the story using the puppets.
- It's always fun to ask your child if they know what a word means. You might get a great answer! Also, you can find out what your child knows.
- Along with vocabulary, your child can also learn an important life lesson. The moral of this one is: It is best to prepare for the days of necessity.
