ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Watch today's story: After The Storm by Nick Butterworth (on our Rising 4's YouTube channel: https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCn9Kx_D9nnBpQO2txIssq-A)
- Have a discussion with your child about the story and ask direct questions.
- Who are the main characters in the story? Who is your favourite character?
- Where is the story set? (Is it set in space or the jungle?)
- O What is the problem/main event in the story?
- O How does the story end?
- Did you enjoy this story? Which part was your favourite/why?

Main Activity:

Explain to your child that Percy has heard one of your class's Golden rules is: You are Kind and Helpful. Percy has asked for some help to make new homes for the animals.

- Your challenge is to build a new home for some of the animals.
- Firstly decide which animals you are going to build a home for.
- O Who will you make a home for?
- O What type of home do you think they would like?
- O What will you use to make the home?

Encourage your child to choose the materials they need. Whilst they are building ask your child questions:

- O How many animals do you think can fit into the home?
- O How will you make the windows?
- o How will the animals get in and out?

Activity review:

- What did you enjoy about this activity?
- O Did you find anything tricky?
- o If you were to do this activity again what would you change?

Additional ways to support your child:

Encourage your child to talk about their creative process. Show him/her ways to assemble the home. Remember the learning is in the process of creating and not the end product.
