



# Individual Activity Lesson Plan

<b>Date:</b> Friday 29 <sup>th</sup> May 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> The Awe and Wonder of London	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> To talk about past and present events in their own lives and in the lives of family members.	<b>Activity Overview.</b> To draw /paint a London landmark for Paddington.
<b>Links to EYFS:</b> <b>Understanding the world</b> Remembers and talks about significant events in their own experience. <b>Personal social and emotional</b> Tries to give help or comfort when others are distressed.	
<b>Equipment :</b> -Pictures of London Landmarks -A3 piece of paper -Coloured pencils -A variety of paint colours	<b>Key vocabulary:</b> Feelings, cheer, comfort, landmark, draw paint, image, shape, size, colour, favourite, visit.
<b>ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)</b>	
<b>Introduction:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Paddington is feeling very lonely and misses his home.</li> <li>You put your thinking cap on.</li> </ul> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You have thought of a great idea to cheer him up.</li> <li>You have decided to share some of the exciting places he can visit in London.</li> </ul>	
<b>Main Activity:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show your child some pictures of London Landmarks (attached below or search your own).</li> <li>Ask him/her the following questions.</li> </ul> <p>-Can you remember an interesting place you have visited in London?</p> <p>-Can you share why you found it interesting?</p> <p>-Can you share what you did there?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask your child to draw/paint a picture of a favourite place they have visited.</li> <li>Alternatively they can draw/paint a picture of somewhere they would like to visit.</li> </ul>	
<b>Challenge</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Paddington comes from Peru.</li> <li>Can you research Peru and find out something interesting?</li> <li>You may find out about a type of fruit or a landmark.</li> </ul>	
<b>Additional ways to support your child:</b> Remind your child of a family outing by looking at some family photos. Encourage him/her to pay attention to detail when creating their picture. Look at shapes and height of their image.	<b>Extension:</b> Can you paint or draw place that you and Paddington can visit together.
