ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Paddington is feeling very lonely and misses his home.
- You put your thinking cap on.





- You have thought of a great idea to cheer him up.
- You have decided to share some of the exciting places he can visit in London.

Main Activity:

- Show your child some pictures of London Landmarks (attached below or search your own).
- Ask him/her the following questions.
- -Can you remember an interesting place you have visited in London?
- -Can you share why you found it interesting?
- -Can you share what you did there?
 - Ask your child to draw/paint a picture of a favourite place they have visited.
 - Alternatively they can draw/paint a picture of somewhere they would like to visit.

Challenge

- Paddington comes from Peru.
- Can you research Peru and find out something interesting?
- You may find out about a type of fruit or a landmark.

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Additional ways to support your child:	Extension:	
Remind your child of a family outing by looking at some family photos. Encourage him/her to pay attention to detail when creating their picture. Look at shapes and height of their image.	Can you paint or draw place that you and Paddington can visit together.	
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
