

Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Thursday 14th May 2020

Activity Title: *Vegetable Glue Collage*

Learning Intention: Makes connections between their movement and the marks they make.

Links to EYFS: Physical Development: Making Relationships: 16-26 months.

Resources:

- Glue
- Green food colouring or paint
- Images of vegetables (cut from flyers/magazines or printed)
- Brush or glue spreader (you could use a toothbrush instead)

Activity Overview:

The children will create a collage using green glue and vegetable images.

Key vocabulary:

Mix, stick, paste, spread, brush, choose, picture, where.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)

Introduction:

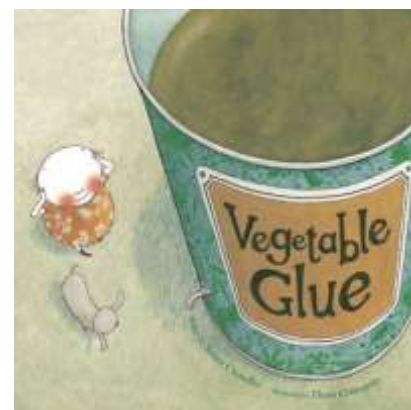
- Play the story *Vegetable Glue* for your child on our YouTube channel.
- Prepare the resources and explain the activity in simple terms. "You can make a picture of your favourite vegetables with the glue from the story."

Main Activity:

- Give your child a variety of options for images and let them explore and create.
- Support your child with key words and phrases to describe what they are doing.
- Model how to apply the glue to the paper and stick the images down.

Activity review:

- Talk about the picture your child has created, which images they chose, the different colours and shapes, etc. Display your child's picture in the kitchen!



Additional ways to support your child:

Add some small pieces or tissue paper, fabric, glitter, etc. for your child to choose from.

Extension:

Encourage your child to try drawing their own vegetables with pencils, crayons, etc.
