Give a Mouse a Cookie



Resources:

- Paper plate
- Paint (brown or grey)
- Cardboard paper (brown)
- Card paper (white)
- Markers (brown, black, pink and grey)
- Scissors
- Glue



1. To make the cookies, cut circles out of the cardboard. (If needed, paint the circles brow and leave to dry.)



2. Using a brown marker, draw chocolate chips on your cookies.



3. Alternatively, you can create chocolate chips using finger prints or cotton buds dipped in brown paint.



4. To make the mouse, paint the paper plate brown/grey. Leave it to dry.



5. Cut out two mouse ears out of the white card paper. Colour them using pink and brown/grey markers.



on the top of the paper plate. Using markers, draw the eyes, nose and whiskers. Using scissors, cut out a slit for the mouth to fit in the cookies.

6. Glue the ears
