ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

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* Introduce the story in focus, read the book or watch and listen to the story online pausing at key moments.

- * Give them a moment to think and browse through the book(s) and then discuss the dinosaurs and what they saw and what happened.
- *Display the dinosaurs and books with the resources and let your child explore and investigate and let them test their ideas use the pictures as a reference.

Main Activity:

*Explain that you are going to create a dinosaur skeleton using pasta. Look at the key features like the head, legs, arms and feet.

*Model making one of the dinosaurs from our story - Stegosaurus, whilst verbalising your thinking.
