ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)

Introduction:

- Read or listen to the story *Giraffes Can't Dance* by Giles Andreae with your child.
- Play and listen to the music video (linked above).

Main Activity:

- Encourage your child to experiment with the different pots and pans, discovering the sounds they can
- Play the music video and show your child how to play along, trying to create an exciting rhythm.
- Talk about the different types of noises your child makes.
- Encourage your child to try playing quiet and then loud, slow and then fast.

Challenge:

- Ask your child questions such as:
- *How fast can you play?
- *Does this pan sound loud or quiet?
- *How can we make a quiet sound?
