


Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Wednesday 10 th June 2020	
Activity Title: Rainbow Collage	
Learning Intention: Explores and experiments with a range of media through sensory exploration, and using whole body.	Activity Overview: The children will create a rainbow using glue and colourful materials.
Links to EYFS: Expressive Arts and Design: Exploring Media and Materials: 16-26 months.	
Resources: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Small pieces of paper, card or other materials in a variety of colours. (You could cut up magazines, wrappers, packaging, etc.) • Glue • Paper or card 	Key vocabulary: Rainbow, colours, red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, arch, line, stick, glue, choose.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)	
Introduction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gather the materials together and invite your child to try out the activity. • Look at some pictures of rainbows together, talking about the shape and all the different colours. 	
Main Activity: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support your child in sticking the colourful materials on the paper to create a rainbow. • You could draw out a basic template or let your child create their own interpretation. 	
Activity review: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Display your child's picture somewhere suitable to share it with the whole family. Try singing the rainbow song together! 	
Additional ways to support your child: Draw a rainbow guide for your child to follow by using a marker to make an arched line with each colour. Your child can then stick materials along these lines in the corresponding colours.	Extension: If using PV or homemade glue, try adding colour to it and putting each different colour in a different pot. Your child can use the red glue to stick the red materials down, etc.
