

# Activity Lesson Plan

## Rising 3's

<b>Date:</b> Wednesday 3 <sup>rd</sup> June 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> I Know a Word - Game	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> - To recognise familiar words and signs.	<b>Activity Overview:</b> Your child will have fun with rhythm, rhyme and rhyming words.
<b>Links to EYFS:</b> • Literacy	
<b>Resources:</b> - Adults and children! 😊😊 Best resources ever!	<b>Key vocabulary:</b> Rhythm, rhyme, the same, different, sound, listen, say, repeat.

### ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

**Introduction**

-Throughout the course of daily activities, encourage your child to think about and play with rhyming words.

**Activity:**

- Begin with the prompt "I know a word that rhymes with 'cat', you put one on your head and the word is... 'hat'"
- This prompt can be used for all kinds of situations, just have fun and enjoy!
- Names can be used too: "I know a girl with a dolly, she is in the kitchen and her name is...'Molly'"
- Once your child is familiar with the game, he/she will fill in the missing word himself/herself.
