Individual Activity Lesson Plan



Date: Tuesday 2nd June 2020

Activity Title: On the Way Home Drawing

Learning Intention: To recognise, describe and draw an event.

Activity Overview: Your child will draw their favourite encounter which Claire had.

Links to EYFS:


- Gives meaning to marks they make as they draw, write and paint (Literacy).
- Create simple representations of events, people and objects (Expressive Arts and Design).

Resources:

- Pencil
- Paper
- Colouring Pencils
- Felt tips

Key vocabulary: Claire, friends, mum, story, what happens next, what happened before, beginning, middle, end, plot, story, main characters, characters, setting, what do you think Claire should have said instead, colourful, etc.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)



Introduction:

 Read today's focus story (follow the link on the daily timetable).

Main Activity:

- Give your child the opportunity to discuss the book with you and ask open ended questions.
- Can you tell me who Claire met on the way home?
- What is your favourite encounter that Claire has and why?
- How do you think Claire felt?
- Invite your child to then draw his/her favourite encounter which Claire had.

Challenge:

• Can you change the story and tell your own version using people in your family?

Additional ways to support your child:

- Ask your child what happened in the story using the terms:
 - o Beginning,
 - o Middle
 - o End
- Revisit the story again if need be and encourage your child to draw his/her favourite part of the story.

Extension:

Challenge your child to create and write a new story with the title *On The Way Home*, applying their phonetic knowledge.
