


# Individual Activity Lesson Plan

<b>Date:</b> Monday 8 <sup>th</sup> June 2020	
<b>Activity Title:</b> Squirrel Sequencing	
<b>Learning Intention:</b> To complete patterns.	<b>Activity Overview:</b> Your child will use cut out pictures to complete premade squirrel patterns.
<b>Links to EYFS:</b> Uses familiar objects to create and recreate patterns. (Maths) Uses one - handed tools and equipment, e.g. makes snips in paper with child scissors. (PD)	
<b>Resources:</b> -Scissors -Sequence pattern activity sheet -Glue (If you don't have a printer available follow the link and play an interactive pattern game on a device <a href="http://resources.hwb.wales.gov.uk/VTC/simple_patterns/eng/Introduction/MainSession.htm">http://resources.hwb.wales.gov.uk/VTC/simple_patterns/eng/Introduction/MainSession.htm</a> )	<b>Key vocabulary:</b> Pattern, first, second, third, fourth, next, previous, after, before, names of the animals.
<b>ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)</b>	
<p><b>Introduction:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After listening to today's story "The Squirrels who squabbled", explain to your child that they are going to complete 'Squirrel' patterns.</li> </ul> <p><b>Main Activity:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>First, to strengthen your child's fine motor skills we would like your child to cut out the bottom strip on the activity sheet.</li> <li>Next, model the activity for your child whilst explaining the need to look closely and carefully at each picture.</li> </ul> <p><b>Example of activity sheet:</b></p>  <p><b>Key questions:</b> Which picture comes next? Can you describe your pattern to me?</p>	
<p><b>Additional ways to support your child:</b> Cut the individual images on the activity sheet up and create a repeating pattern using just 2 of the images. Invite your child to complete the pattern.</p>	<p><b>Extension:</b> Print another activity sheet out and cut all of the pieces up. Now ask your child to use the pieces to create their own sequence patterns.</p>
