


Individual Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Wednesday 1 st July 2020	
Activity Title: What’s your Superpower?	
Learning Intention: to use talk to explain ideas (and then use their knowledge to engage in a range of activities).	Activity Overview: Consider which superpower you would choose and create a mini superhero version of yourself.
Links to EYFS: Understanding the world: -Talks about why things happen and how things work. Communication and Language: -Uses talk to connect ideas, explain what is happening and anticipate what might happen next, relive and recall past experiences.	
Resources: -Superhero Bingo - word and picture boards (printed) - Superhero Bingo – word and picture cards (printed) -Superhero Template (attached below lesson plan) -Mark making tools (felt tips, crayons, paints etc.) -Decorative resources (sequins, feathers, glue, scissors etc.)	Key vocabulary: Superhero, heroes, powers, skills, props, cape, mask, fly, super speed, super strength, invisibility, transform.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
Introduction: *Print the superhero picture cards and look through them with your child. Discuss each of the superpowers/props superheroes require. -Which superpower would you like to have? -What could you do with this power? -How would you use your power? -What would you do with it? *Encourage your child to think through the different powers they would choose to have and why.	
Option 1 – Create a Superhero Version of Yourself *Print the superhero outline (attached below the lesson plan) or draw your own. *Explain to your child he/she is going to create a mini version of themselves as a superhero. *Encourage your child to consider how the superpowers they have chosen (in the intro) will be reflected in their superhero costume e.g. if they can fly, they may want to wear a cape or if they can shoot ice, they may want to have an icicle themed outfit. *Encourage your child to gather the resources/materials they require and be as independent as possible.	
Option 2 - Family Bingo Game *Print the Superhero Bingo boards and cards. *Cut the cards out individually. *Look through the superhero cards together with your child and discuss the different powers/superhero props. Once you have looked through all the cards, place them face down in a pile. *Give out the bingo boards – one to each player. *Choose one person to be the caller. The caller will turn one card over at a time. *If the players have the matching card on their board, they should cross it out. *The player who crosses all of their boxes first is the winner.	



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Additional ways to support your child:

Support your child by taking the time to discuss each superpower in depth. Then share with your child which superpowers you would like and explain your reasoning.

Extension:

Challenge your child to make a 3D prop for his/her character, based on their powers. E.g if they can walk through fire, make a fire hoop (decorate a hoop with strips of orange and yellow paper) or if they can shoot ice, make a ice wand!
