## Activity Title: Rhyming pairs

Learning Intention: To identify objects which rhyme.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

## Introduction:

- After listening to today's story 'The Dinosaur café' ask your child if they noticed any rhyming words in the story.
- Listen to the story again to try and find as many rhyming words as you can together.

Main Activity:

- Print off today's rhyming activity sheet.
- Explain to your child that they will need to draw a line from one picture to another matching the rhyming pairs.
- As your child matches the pairs correctly, encourage them to come up with a third rhyming word.
- Offer your child the opportunity to draw pictures of their additional rhyming word.
