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ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key question)

Introduction:

Listen to our focus story Supertato Veggies Assemble (on the Rising 4's Youtube Channel)

Ask your child the following questions:

Who is Evil Pea?

What did he do in the supermarket?

How can we warn other people about Evil Pea?

Main Activity:

- Explain to your child that they are going to make a wanted poster.
- Ask them if they know what a wanted poster is?
- Explain to them that it is a large picture and writing to warn people of criminals.
- Tell your child that you are going to make a wanted poster to warn people about Evil Pea.
- Explain the headings to your child.
- Encourage them to design a wanted poster using the template.
