

Activity Lesson Plan

Date: Monday 22th June 2020

Activity Title: Dinosaur Foot Printing- Harry and the Dinosaurs

Learning Intention: Experiment and creates art and craft with different colours and shapes.

Activity Overview: The children to use potatoes and sponges to make dinosaur footprints.

Links to EYFS: Expressive art and design

Resources:

Potatoes/ sponge
Paint
Paper
Knife

Key vocabulary: Potatoes, cut, shape, paw, print, feet, dinosaur, claws, paint.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

Talk to your child about what they are going to do.

Show them pictures of dinosaur foot prints. Allow your child to choose which dinosaurs they want to use for their foot printing. What shape/size is this dinosaur foot print?

*Is this the same one we just looked at?

*Are they all the same.

*What's different/same about the footprints.

Main Activity:

With your child cut out dinosaur foot print on a potato. (You can also use a sponge). Adult will need to do this. You can allow your child to have a try or why not let them draw the dinosaur print and adult to cut. Don't forget to talk to your child about the safety of using a knife too! Then let your child choose the colour paint they will like to use to make the foot prints on the paper.

*I wonder what foot print you will choose?

*Can you describe what shape this is?

*How many prints are there altogether?

*Can you point to the big/small prints?
