# **Individual Activity Lesson Plan**



**Date:** Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2020

Activity Title: I Packed in my Suitcase...

Learning Intention: To build memory skills.	Activity Overview: To engage in a fun memory
Links to EYFS:	recall activity, with a holiday
Communication & Language	theme.
Joins in with repeated refrains and anticipates key events and phrases in	
rhymes and stories.	
Personal & Social and Emotional Development

Equipment:	Key vocabulary: I, packed, in.
Template – 'I Packed in my Suitcase Items'.	my, suitcase, before, after, next.

## **ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)**

### Introduction:

- Explain to your child that you are going to play a fun memory game.
- The game is called "I Packed in my Suitcase..."
- The aim of the game is to remember the list of items that you would pack in your imaginary suitcase.

### Main Activity:

- Ask your child to put their thinking head on .
- What items would they would take on holiday?

(Alternatively you can use the images from the additional template).

- Start the game by saying," I packed in my suitcase a toothbrush"
- Invite your child to repeat your sentence and add another item e.g.

"I packed my suitcase a toothbrush and some toothpaste"

- Choose items which are memorable to your child.
- The game should continue until your child cannot remember an item.
- Start off with up to 2 item's each 4 in total.
- Extend the amount of items to challenge your child.

To prompt your child's memory you could sound out the initial letter of the item or do an action.

### Remember the aim of the game is to have fun!

Additional ways to support your child:	Extension:
To support your child's memory recall you can use a set of visual items	When your child gets familiar with the activity, you can swap roles! Now your child starts the activity. Try to use a different item from the ones previously used.
