Individual Activity Lesson Plan



Date: 7 th July 2020	
Activity Title: Bubble Painting - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=z4i3Pp_ciwA	
Learning Intention: Understands that different media can be combined to create new effect Links to EYFS:	Activity Overview: The children to do bubble painting and have fun, explore and learn.
Expressive Arts and Design	
Resources: Washing up liquid Paint Straw Paper Water	Key vocabulary: Bubble, pop, paint, round, colour, blow, straw.

ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)

Introduction:

- Explain to your child that you are going to do bubble painting.
- Give then a selection of colours of paint to choose from.

Main Activity:

- Mix together the paint and some washing up liquid in the tray. Add some water
 until it is runny enough to blow bubbles. Use the drinking straw to blow into the paint to make
 bubbles.
- Model to your child on how to blow to make the bubbles using a straw. (Don't drink it!)
- Gently place the paper on top of the bubbles. When the bubbles pop remove the paper and leave to dry.

'I'm going to blow softly and watch the bubbles'

- I wonder how big the bubble will be.
- I wonder how you will blow.
- What do you need to do now?
