Activity Title: Decorating Cupcakes	
Learning Intention:	Activity Overview: Decorate cupcakes to celebrate Eid with a tasty treat.
Links to EYFS: Personal, Social and Emotional Development: Self-Confidence and Self-Awareness: 30-50 months.	
Resources:	Key vocabulary:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mixing bowl • Large spoon/spatula • Cupcake tray • Cupcake cases • Icing sugar • Sprinkles/other cake decorations • Optional: Food colouring • Measuring jug • Flour • Sugar • Butter (or non-dairy spread) • Eggs (oil for dairy-free alternative) • Optional: Cocoa powder/vanilla/orange essence for a different flavour. 	Cake, decorate, sweet, mix, Eid, celebrate, bake, pour, sprinkle, spoon, taste, smell.
ACTIVITY IMPLEMENTATION (including key questions)	
Introduction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk briefly about Eid and why it is celebrated. • Explain to your child that they can make some cupcakes to celebrate this festival. Main Activity: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use your favourite cupcake recipe to follow and encourage your child to carry out as many of the steps as possible. • You could add a special flavour or colour to the sponge or the icing, or both. • Once the cakes have cooled, decorate them with icing and other edible decorations. Activity Review <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How do your cakes taste? How do they smell? • What colour is your cake/the icing? • Who will you share your cakes with? 	
Additional ways to support your child: Give very clear and simple instructions to your child to follow. You could hold the utensils together to support your child in controlling them.	Extension: Try using writing icing to create moon and star shapes on your cupcakes!
